



The Summary of Benefits and Coverage (SBC) document will help you choose a health plan. The SBC shows you how you and the plan would share the cost for covered health care services. NOTE: Information about the cost of this plan (called the premium) will be provided separately. This is only a summary. Important Questions	Answers	Why this Matters:
What is the overall deductible?	In-Network: \$5,000 Individual/\$10,000 Family. Out-of-Network: \$10,000 Individual/\$20,000 Family.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. <u>Preventive care</u> .	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. For example, this <u>plan</u> covers certain <u>preventive services</u> without <u>cost sharing</u> and before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . Are there other deductibles for specific services?	No.	You don't have to meet <u>deductibles</u> for specific services.
What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan?	In-Network: \$7,500 Individual/\$15,000 Family. Out-of-Network: \$15,000 Individual/\$30,000 Family.	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <u>plan</u> , they have to meet their own <u>out-of-pocket limits</u> until the overall family <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> has been met.
What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?	<u>Premiums</u> , <u>balance-billing</u> charges, health care this <u>plan</u> doesn't cover and penalties for failure to obtain <u>pre-authorization</u> for services.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> .
Will you pay less if you use a network provider?	Yes. See www.bluecrossnc.com/FindADoctor or call 1-877-258-3334 for a list of <u>network providers</u> .	This <u>plan</u> uses a <u>provider network</u> . You will pay less if you use a <u>provider</u> in the <u>plan's network</u> . You will pay the most if you use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> , and you might receive a bill from a <u>provider</u> for the difference between the <u>provider's</u> charge and what your <u>plan</u> pays (<u>balance billing</u>). Be aware your <u>network provider</u> might use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> for some services (such as lab work). Check with your <u>provider</u> before you get services.

Do you need a referral to see a specialist?

No.

You can see the specialist you choose without a referral.

Excluded Services & Other Covered Services:

Services Your Plan Generally Does NOT Cover (Check your policy or plan document for more information and a list of any other excluded services.)

- Acupuncture
- Long-term care
- Weight loss programs
- Cosmetic surgery
- Routine eye care (Adult)
- Dental care (Adult)
- Routine foot care that is palliative or cosmetic.

HSA funds, if available, may be used to cover eligible medical expenses.

- Bariatric surgery
- Infertility treatment
- Chiropractic care
- Non-emergency care when traveling outside the U.S.

Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes

Minimum Essential Coverage generally includes plans, health insurance available through the Marketplace or other individual market policies, Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, TRICARE, and certain other coverage. If you are eligible for certain types of Minimum Essential Coverage, you may not be eligible for the premium tax credit.

Does this plan meet the Minimum Value Standards? Yes

If your plan doesn't meet the Minimum Value Standards, you may be eligible for a premium tax credit to help you pay for a plan through the Marketplace.

About these Coverage Examples:



This is not a cost estimator. Treatments shown are just examples of how this plan might cover medical care. Your actual costs will be different depending on the actual care you receive, the prices your providers charge, and many other factors. Focus on the cost sharing amounts (deductibles, copayments and coinsurance) and excluded services under the plan. Use this information to compare the portion of costs you might pay under different health plans. Please note these coverage examples are based on self-only coverage.

Peg is Having a Baby
(9 months of in-network pre-natal care and a hospital delivery)

- **The plan's overall deductible** \$5,000
- **Specialist coinsurance** 20%
- **Hospital (facility) coinsurance** 20%
- **Other coinsurance** 20%

This EXAMPLE event includes services like:
Specialist office visits (*prenatal care*)
 Childbirth/Delivery Professional Services
 Childbirth/Delivery Facility Services
Diagnostic tests (*ultrasounds and blood work*)
Specialist visit (*anesthesia*)

Total Example Cost \$12,700

In this example, Peg would pay:

<i>Cost Sharing</i>	
Deductibles	\$5,000
Copayments	\$0
Coinsurance	\$1,280
<i>What isn't covered</i>	
Limits or exclusions	\$60
The total Peg would pay is	\$6,340

Managing Joe's Type 2 Diabetes
(a year of routine in-network care of a well-controlled condition)

- **The plan's overall deductible** \$5,000
- **Specialist coinsurance** 20%
- **Hospital (facility) coinsurance** 20%
- **Other coinsurance** 20%

This EXAMPLE event includes services like:
Primary care physician office visits (*including disease education*)
Diagnostic tests (*blood work*)
Prescription drugs
Durable medical equipment (*glucose meter*)

Total Example Cost \$5,600

In this example, Joe would pay:

<i>Cost Sharing</i>	
Deductibles	\$2,590
Copayments	\$0
Coinsurance	\$550
<i>What isn't covered</i>	
Limits or exclusions	\$20
The total Joe would pay is	\$3,160

Mia's Simple Fracture
(in-network emergency room visit and follow up care)

- **The plan's overall deductible** \$5,000
- **Specialist coinsurance** 20%
- **Hospital (facility) coinsurance** 20%
- **Other coinsurance** 20%

This EXAMPLE event includes services like:
Emergency room care (*including medical supplies*)
Diagnostic test (*x-ray*)
Durable medical equipment (*crutches*)
Rehabilitation services (*physical therapy*)

Total Example Cost \$2,800

In this example, Mia would pay:

Deductibles	\$2,800
Copayments	\$0
Coinsurance	\$0
<i>What isn't covered</i>	
Limits or exclusions	\$0
The total Mia would pay is	\$2,800
